Springhill

Welcome to Springhill, Wentworth & Oxford! Springhill blends deep roots with fresh energy. Born as a coal town in the 1800s, its stories of bravery through mining disasters are preserved at the Springhill Miners Museum and Lamp Cabin Memorial Park, while the Anne Murray Centre celebrates a hometown icon. Today the community looks ahead with innovative geothermal projects tapping former mines, welcoming trails and parks, and the lively Dr. Carson & Marion Murray Community Centre for year-round recreation.



Wentworth

Wentworth is your valley for four-season adventure. Long part of Mi'kma'ki and later a corridor for Acadian, Loyalist and Scottish settlers moving between the Minas Basin and the Northumberland Strait, the valley still shows its rural heritage in historic farms and sugar camps. Hike to sweeping lookoffs in the Cobequid Mountains, picnic at Wentworth Provincial Park, bike sections of the Great Trail, ski, hike, or bike the renowned slopes and explore nearby ATV routes.



Oxford

Known as the Wild Blueberry Capital of Canada, Oxford grew from its roots along the River Philip into a global hub for wild blueberries. Stroll along riverside trails and browse family-run shops, including GJDE Enterprises Ltd., an award-winning gift shop over flowing with charm and unique treasures. Step back in time at the historic Capitol Theatre, an Art Deco landmark showcasing live performances since 1923. Before you go, be sure to snap a photo with Oxley, the famous Big Blueberry, a true Oxford icon.

Ski & Bike Wentworth

Nestled in the heart of the Wentworth Valley, this mountain playground is your four-season destination for outdoor fun and fresh air.

Winter brings alpine and cross-country skiing, snowboarding, tree skiing, terrain parks, and snowshoeing through forest trails. When the snow melts, Wentworth transforms into a summer and fall adventure hub. Explore scenic hiking trails, tackle a challenging mountain bike park, play a round of 18-hole disc golf, or take in the stunning fall colours from the chairlift.

After your adventure, unwind at the base where you'll find a perfect spot to relax, eat, and share stories from the day.



On the Green in Springhill & Collingwood

In Springhill, the Centennial Golf Club offers a welcoming 9-hole course with rolling greens and relaxed play for every skill level. Nearby in Collingwood Corner, a new 18-hole golf resort is taking shape along River Philip, adding another great option to Cumberland's growing list of golf destinations.
